I am a defendant in the above captioned matter appearing pro se. The present scheduling order indicates that May 4, 2010 is the last day for parties to enter the case.

I have personal knowledge that a substantial number of landowners here at Goose Rocks Beach will be entering the case as defendants to preserve their prescriptive rights to recreate on the beach.

Unfortunately the attorney who was engaged to represent this group can no longer do so because Plaintiff's counsel revoked an earlier granted consent, waiving a potential conflict, from his clients that would have allowed said attorney to be engaged by the group.

Now this substantial and ever growing group has to seek alternative counsel for representation in a timely manner which may be very difficult in light of the May 4th deadline.

I am requesting that you extend this deadline for a reasonable period. This would allow these additional parties who have in my view a legitimate claim the right to appear.
